Silver City Medallion Hunt





City of Sherrill Centennial Parade, Saturday July 30, 2016, 1pm Route, Viewing Information and Parking

The parade will start at the top of Reilly-Mumford Park, continue on Sherrill Road to East Hamilton Ave, turn left and end at Park Street and East Hamilton Ave. There will be a reviewing stand in front of the Sherrill Post Office. View the parade along Reilly-Mumford Park, Sherrill Road or on Hamilton Ave by Noyes Park! Please note- Prospect Street and Sherrill Road between Route 5 and Kinsley Street will be blocked off for parade lineup. Parking will be reserved for parade participants in the lot across from Savon, at Sherrill Manufacturing and at the CAC. The lot adjacent to Plymouth Alliance Church and the Skating Rink will also be blocked off for event set up. Residents are encouraged to walk or carpool as parking will be limited. Parking will be available on side streets and in some lots around Sherrill. Please plan to allow extra time to get to events throughout the weekend in case traffic is stopped or parking is limited.
