## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A team has 5 minutes to report to the boards. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.
2. Maximum of 4 games will take place at any given time.
3. Coolers are allowed.
4. Substitute players can fill in for missing teammates. For the "sub" to play in the year end tournament, the "sub" must have played in at least one regular season match.
5. If your team has a scheduling conflict it is up to your team to contact your opponent to reschedule. Make-ups are on Tuesday evenings from 5:00pm – 6:00pm. If a team can't make their normal game or the makeup, they will forfeit and take the loss (zero points).
6. Next schedule game will start immediately following game before, no breaks.
7. Players must be at least 21 years of age as of 1/16/19.
8. Please always keep language and behavior appropriate and observe good sportsmanship.
9. First team to 21 points wins the game. Best out of 3 matches. There is NO bust rule and teams can exceed 21 points in a turn.
10. Cancellation scoring will be used. EX: 1 bag on the board for each team = 0 points scored
11. 3 points for bag in the hole, 1 point for each bag on the board.
12. Teams will "Rock, Paper, Scissors" (best of 3) to determine who throws first. Winner picks their order.
13. Players will be across from each other on the course. Teams alternate throwing a total of 4 bags.
14. The team that scored the previous throw will be the first team to throw next turn.
15. Throwers must remain behind the front of the cornhole board when tossing or that bag will be discarded.
16. A thrown bag is determined by the forward swing of the arm. A dropped bag will not count as a throw.
17. Bags are not to be removed from the boards until all bags for both teams are thrown. Bags removed prematurely will result in a point deduction for each bag removed.
18. Bags that contact the ground or another object before hitting the board will not be scored. Those bags are to be removed from the board before the next bag is thrown.
19. If there is a question about the game, players should call an official over and explain the situation calmly and await a decision.
20. OFFICIALS HAVE THE FINAL SAY – PLEASE DO NOT ARGUE THE DECISIONS.
21. Most importantly, remember this is a game – please have fun.
22. Standings: A weekly best out 3 wins, will equate to 1 point in the standings. Zero points will be given for a loss.
23. There will be two divisions and each team will play 7 games in their division, and in week 8 you will play your equal seed/standing in from the alternate division. Tie breaker will be head to head. The winner of week 8's number 1 seed game will be the 1 overall seed for week 9's tournament. The loser will be the number 2 over all seed and so on. Tiebreaker is Head to Head. 3-way tie will be broken via coin flip.
